

Preliminary Montage Calls FAQs

Q- When should I get my pictures to you by?

A- As soon as possible, but no later than 3 weeks before the event date. Montage packages received after the 3 week deadline are subject to an additional fee.

Q- I have more than 60 images, is that OK?

A- If you are contracted for a 60 image montage, there is a fee for additional photos. As a courtesy to our clients, we usually waive the fee for up to 5 additional images, but anymore there is a charge.

Q- Should I drop them off or mail them?

A- Either or. Dropping off might be better so a SAS staff member can review the material with you to make sure it's ready for production. If you're mailing your photos, be sure that all photos are numbered in the order in which you want them to appear. SAS does not accept montage materials that are not numbered. You must complete the Montage Package form which includes the Montage Agreement and submit it with your photos.

Q- I have digital and printed pictures, how should I number them?

A- We ask all images are in numerical order for the montage. We DO NOT accept montage packages that are not numbered in the order that they should appear. (ie: If image 1 is a print image, and image 2 is a digital image, the print image should be labeled with a 1 on the back of the print and the digital image should be renamed as 002.jpg, etc.)

Q- When will I see my montage?

A- No later than 5 business days before the event date. A link will be sent to you via email.

Q- If I have revisions after I see my montage, who should I contact?

A- Directly contact the editor who sent you the montage link. If you don't have the editor's email address you can email or call the studio.

Q- I have a video clip but I'm not sure where the specific clip is on the reel. What do I do?

A- We ask that before your montage meeting you try and find the clip and write down the minute and seconds for the start and stop times. If you are unable to do this, we can have our videographer and/or editor review the footage with you at an additional fee.
